FBH Program Guidelines: Technical Amendment June 26, 2024



Eligibility for SGC Pre-Development Fund



To be eligible for the SGC FBH Program all proposals must:

- 1. Have already passed DOE Title 1703 Clean Energy Financing Fund Part I
- 2. Be in the process of applying for DOE Title 1703 Part II

| Justice40 Initiative | Manufacturing facility must be sited in a Justice40-designated disadvantaged community. (Different from California-defined DAC) |
| Workforce & Community Benefits Agreement | Commit to Workforce and Community Benefits Agreement that ensures community and/or workforce benefits of project. |

How to invite others to collaborate on an application

- Click Manage Collaborators at the top right of the application.
- A dialog box will appear enter the email addresses of your collaborators and click Invite.
- Collaborators will receive an email from Submittable letting them know you've
 invited them to collaborate on an in-progress application. If they do not have a
 Submittable account, they will be prompted to create one.
- Collaborators can edit the form, but they cannot submit it. Only the main applicant can submit the form.

How to save & return to your application

- If you cannot finish your application all at once, that's okay!
- Submittable automatically saves a draft of your application after every change you make.
- You can also manually save your draft by clicking the 'save draft' button at the bottom of the application.
- To view your draft and continue working on an application, sign in to your Submittable account, click the 'drafts' button, and choose 'continue' on the application you want to keep working on.
 - How can I return to a saved draft?



Important Notes for Applicants

- SGC strongly encourages applicants to closely review and reference the <u>FBH Pre-Development Pilot</u> <u>Program Guidelines</u> while preparing their application.
- Each application section includes instructions and directs the applicant to the section of the FBH Program Guidelines that corresponds to that set of questions.
- The Scoring Criteria (Section 5.3 of the Program Guidelines) provides a breakdown of the point system, weighting, and priorities that reviewers will use to assess each response and application component.

- *Red asterisks next to a question or upload box mean that that component is required.
- Please note and apply required naming convention for each type of file before uploading documents.

- For-profit Applicants must provide a current annual organizational budget and recent financial statements
- Non-profit organizations must submit a copy of their most recent Federal Form 990 and a copy of the organization's IRS 501(c)(3) Tax Determination Letter
 in addition to their current annual budget and recent financial statements.



Branching Questions

- Some application questions will "branch" into other questions or required components depending upon the user's response to that question.
- After the user selects a response to an branching question, another question or step will appear beneath the initial question.
- Example: answering "Yes" to whether co-applicants will be involved in the proposed project.
