# Tribal Capacity Building Pilot Program



### **ABOUT THE PROGRAM**

The Tribal Capacity Building Pilot Program is a new grant program that provides funding and technical assistance to California Native American tribes to build staff capacity to advance tribes' climate-related work. Administered by the Strategic Growth Council (SGC), the goal of the pilot program is to assist tribes in developing long-term capacity to secure funding and implement tribal-led climate solutions. The Tribal Capacity Building Pilot Program provides funding and technical assistance to tribes to advance their climate goals

### WHAT DOES THE PROGRAM FUND?

The pilot program will award two-year grants to 4-6 tribes and fund staff salaries and activities that advance the tribe's climate-related work. Activities may include planning, securing funding for, and implementing projects related to climate mitigation, adaptation, and resilience.

## WHAT SERVICES WILL THE PROGRAM PROVIDE?

Tribes will work with a technical assistance provider and receive no-cost, flexible support that will respond to each tribe's needs. The capacity building and technical assistance services offered include, but are not limited to:

- » Trainings & workshops
- » Grant application assistance
- » Grant management support
- » Planning support
- » Implementation assistance
- » Partnership building
- » Peer learning
- » Staff development
- » Economic development

#### WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

California Native American tribes listed on the Native American Heritage Commission (NAHC) Contact List, including federally recognized and non-federally recognized tribes, are eligible to apply. A non-federally recognized tribe is eligible to apply if they are registered as a nonprofit, a for-profit corporation, or a limited liability company.

#### WHAT IS THE AWARD AMOUNT?

Funding is available on a competitive basis with \$1 million total available for grant awards. Awarded tribes may receive funding between \$150,000 and \$250,000 each for the pilot two-year grant term.

#### **PROGRAM TIMELINE**

- » October 26, 2023: Pilot Program Grant Guidelines presented to the Council for approval
- » **November 7, 2023:** Notice of Funding Availability & Application Release
- November 16, 2023-January 25, 2024: Biweekly Office Hours to support applicants during the Application Phase every other Thursday from 2:00 -3:00 p.m. PT
- » February 5, 2024: Applications due by 5:00 p.m. PT
