

- Grant program analysis
 - 12 key grant programs
 - Criteria:
 - Government administered
 - CA focus (with one exception)
 - Contribute directly to land access in a way that allows us to measure "acres transitioned"

- Methodology
 - Publicly available information, existing evaluations
 - Request awardee data
 - Interviews for narratives on experiences with programs
 - Program staff, recipients, and technical assistance providers

Metrics – Application phase:

- Language access (TA or multilingual applications)
- Applicant demographics
- Geographic representation
- Oversubscription rates

Metrics – Eligibility:

- Eligible entities (individual farmer, tribes, etc.)
- Land tenure requirements
- Methods of prioritizing certain applicants

Metrics - Outcomes:

- Awardee demographics
- Acres transitioned and to who
- Long term impact: Is there follow up or support on mid/long term basis after grant period?

- Programs that support Land Back
 - Case studies of Land Back projects
 - Outline associated tribal consultation practices

Research Requests - Survey

- Deeper discussion in Community Outreach Subcommittee
- Survey draft out for review
 - Input on format, questions, or response options
- Survey purpose
- Questions / comments?
