

- 1. Language used was easy to understand
- 2. Understanding what true Land Back means without stipulations
- 3. Caretaking of lands in Native hands leads to different outcomes than with developers
- 4. Statistics from presentation as background context for TF's work
- 5. Restoration of land requires more work than maintaining; \$\$ for planning and restoration
- 6. Land trusts associated challenges
- 7. Consolidation of land ownership in few hands; current conditions are systematic
- 8. Land Back and land return started in 1493; response to colonialization
- 9. What can CA do in relationship to federally owned land and land return?
