- The Eastern Coachella valley produces over \$700 million in agricultural revenues
- According to the 2021 Riverside County Agricultural Commissioner Report 324,895,000 was the valuation for vegetables, melon and others.
- Existing agriculture continue to provide low paying jobs and without health benefits
- Climate change is already impacting our communities including extended high temperatures days during the summer, flooding and air quality
