

Assembly Bill 524 Overview & Discussion

AB 524 Overview

Bill Summary:

- Create Farmland Access and Conservation for Thriving Communities Program.
- Provide financial and technical assistance to support agricultural land acquisition and protection.
- DOC provide financial assistance to qualified entities to acquire agricultural lands to transfer or provide long-term leases to qualified farmer participants.
- DOC may contract with nonprofits to administer program.
- DOC to resource members of the California Agricultural Land Equity Task Force to ensure proper oversight over the development of the program.

AB 524 Overview

Definitions:

"Qualified Entity:"

- Nonprofits
- Public agencies
- Tribal governments
- Tribal entities
- Agricultural land trusts
- Community land trusts

"Qualified Farmer Participant:"

"...a farm enterprise whose beneficial owners are beginning farmers or ranchers, or socially disadvantaged farmers or ranchers, and that commits to using practices, methodologies, and techniques that improve soil health, build biodiversity, conservation, and long-term sustainability in the production of agricultural crops to be sold in commerce or distributed."
