The HiAP Task Force has established policies, programs, and procedures to embed health, Key equity, and sustainability across all sectors of California State government. This is a non-exhaustive list of key milestones in the Task Force's change to advance HiAP in California. Founding legislation or policy 2010 **HiAP** implementation Task Force established under Executive Order S-04-10. Internal milestone Task Force launched through 2011 CDPH and PHI staffing partnership with SGC oversight. HiAP carries out extensive stakeholder engagement to inform 2012 future work. Senate Concurrent Resolution 47 conveys legislative support for HiAP implementation; CDPH Office 2013 of Health Equity created. Charter defines Task Force structure, including 2014 decision-making by consensus.
